Terminal Renovation Project Update

As we shared last month, the Terminal Renovation Project is underway. We will continue to provide regular project updates. Visitors to the terminal this month will notice that fencing has gone up and temporary pedestrian walkways have been put in place to ensure safety as limited demolition activities have begun. Maine DOT Transfer Bridge Repairs Planned on Peaks Island

The transfer bridge on Peaks Island is owned and maintained by the State of Maine. Repairs are scheduled to begin on February 8th and Maine DOT estimates the work will take approximately 12 weeks to complete. During this time, Lionel Plante Associates will be providing vehicle transportation to and from Peaks Island on a scheduled, yet limited, basis. Passenger service will operate on the regular sailing schedule. CBITD has coordinated with Maine DOT so that the Machigonne's routine shipyard work will occur during this timeframe.
